### SALIENT POINTS FROM THE PROCEEDINGS OF THE 37th ANNUAL GENERAL BODY MEETING OF THE IISC PENSIONERS ASSOCIATION HELD ON SUNDAY THE 28th OCTOBER 2018

- 152 members attended the meeting, Mr A L Narasimhan, President of the Association, presided over the Meeting
- · The meeting started with invocation by Mrs. Susheela Nagaraj and Mrs. K. SomavathiDevi..
- Members observed a minute's silence to pay respects to members who left this world during the year.
- · Mr. G. Annapurnaiah, Secretary read out the notice convening the AGM
- · The President extended a warm welcome to all the members.
- The Secretary read out the salient points in the Proceedings of the 36th AGM held on 29.10.2017 and after inviting comments, the Proceedings of the meeting were confirmed.
- The President highlighted the salient points in the Report of the Managing Committee providing statistical information up to the period 31st March 2018 and updated the information up to 31stAugust 2018. The House was informed that:
- The President highlighted the achievements of the MC during the year as also during 2015-2018 and thanked the members of the MC for their cooperation and specially thanked the Institute administration for the concern shown in solving the grievances of the pensioners. He highlighted the additional benefits under the Contributory Health Service Scheme made possible due to constant negotiations with the authorities.
- After inviting comments from the members, the Report of the Managing Committee for the year 2017-18 was adopted.
- The audited statements of accounts for the year 2017-18 together with the Report of the Auditors thereon was considered and approved.
- The Budget Estimates for the year 2018-19 were considered and approved, after providing clarifications on certain queries raised by the members.
- M/s M V Prasanna & Co were appointed as Auditors for the year 2018-19 on existing terms and conditions.
- The President briefed the General Body about the :
- Implementation of the 7th Pay Commission recommendations for the non-academic staff retirees.
- Liberal contributions received from some members to the General Fund consequent to the 7th Pay Commission benefits received.
- o Enhancement in the Assistance provided for both Medical and Non-Medical cases under the Benevolent Fund in view of the good balance position. He also mentioned about the simplification of the application form for seeking assistance under the Benevolent fund.
- Celebration of "Pensioners' Day" for the first time and the enthusiastic response received from the members for the sports events conducted as part of the pensioners' day.
- Extension of benefits under the Contributory Health Service Scheme (CHSS) and improvement in the issue of tokens in the Health Centre.
- · Creation of a Web page for the IISPA.
- Printing of the booklet of the Memorandum of Association and Rules & Regulations of the Association.
- Shifting of the Association office to the new premises in the Alumni Association Building.
- Arranging of lectures on Health related topics.
- The President highlighted the amendments proposed to the rules for the operation of the Benevolent Fund also taking into account the advice of the external auditors. He informed

that the maximum possible money out of the interest income is ploughed back to members. The members approved the amendments proposed.

## REPORT OF THE MANAGING COMMITTEE OF THE INDIAN INSTITUTE OF SCIENCE PENSIONERS' ASSOCIATION FOR THE YEAR 2018-2019

The Managing Committee (MC) of the IISc Pensioners' Association has great pleasure in welcoming members to the **Thirty Eighth Annual General Meeting** of the Association. It is my privilege to present the Report for the year 2018-19 and the Audited Statement of Accounts for the year 2018-19 for your consideration and approval.

Managing Committee meetings: During the year, the Managing Committee met 12 times to discuss various aspects connected with the functioning of the Association. The average attendance during these meetings was around 80%. The new Managing Committee took over in November 2018.

**Membership:** We are happy to inform you that during the year <u>40</u> new members have enrolled themselves to the Association. The details are as follow:

**Finances:** The Audited Statements of Accounts and Report of the Auditors for the year 2018-19 and the Budget Proposals for the year 2019-20 are circulated for approval.

Benevolent Fund: The Benevolent Fund of IISPA is in operation since January 2001 and we are happy to inform the members that the Corpus of the Fund stands at Rs. 38.97 lakhs as on 31.3.2019 compared to Rs. 37.62 lakhs last year. The fund collected so far has been invested in Nationalized Banks. However, the rate of interest is continuously coming down in recent times and hence the yield from the amount deposited is declining year by year. During the year under review, a total financial support of Rs 1,75,846/- was extended to 17 persons.

**General Fund:** A sum of Rs. 1,00,000/- was collected during the period 1st April 2018 to 31st March 2019 as Membership fee. Contributions [totalling Rs. 3,07,501/-] were received from the following individuals to the General Fund (other than the contribution of Rs.500/- each transferred from the Benevolent Fund account of new members). The balance under General Fund, including the Membership Fund and Members' Corpus Fund stood at Rs. 23.17 lakhs as on 31.3.2019.
